
## 2021 CRIME STATISTICS & 5 YEAR REVIEW




The information below provides a 2021 review of crime, calls for service and arrests data for the City of Santa Monica. This information provides an overview of Part I\* type crimes compared to previous years. The past two years have been an anomaly across the country due to the civil unrest of 2020 and the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic. A five year history provides context for our city's most recent crime trends.




Part I crimes were down about 2.9% in 2021.



In 2021, firearm use in Aggravated Assaults shows the highest number of incidents in five years.



A notable decrease is seen in the category of **Rape**, while **Murder** cases remain stable after a spike in 2018.
