

Ocean Ave & California Ave Intersection Improvements Temporary Lane Closures

Street Paving Dates: Monday, April 11, 2022 and Tuesday April 12, 2022

Work Hours: 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

The City of Santa Monica has contracted with PCI and All American Asphalt to renew the pavement surface of the intersection of California Ave. and Ocean Ave. and install signage and bike striping improvements. The contractor will renew the pavement surface on April 11 and April 12, 2022. Construction will be completed in various phases to minimize traffic delays.

Temporary Lane Closures:

During construction, motorists may experience temporary delays in and around the intersection of California Ave. and Ocean Ave.

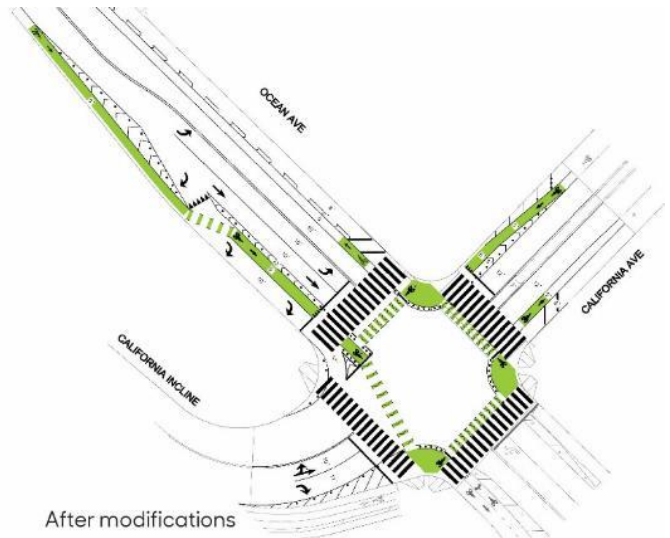
Temporary lane closures will take place during the two days of paving at each location as follows:

- Westbound and eastbound lanes on California Ave.
- California Incline on-ramp to Pacific Coast Highway
- Left turn lanes on Ocean Ave. towards California Ave.

This intersection was restriped in Winter 2020 as the City's first protected intersection design, which provides priority to cyclists. As a result of onsite observations and in response to community feedback, the City will be implementing modifications at the intersection to increase navigability, including green bike markings to guide bicyclists through the intersection, restoration of the southbound right turn lane onto the California Incline, and installation of additional flexible posts to highlight areas of the intersection.
